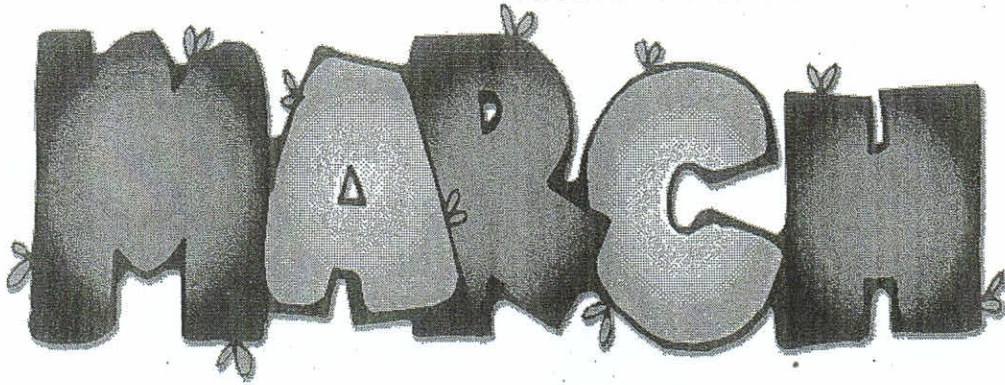
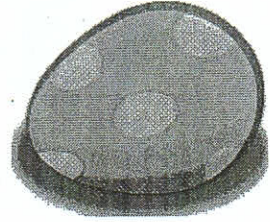

EASTER EGG HUNT

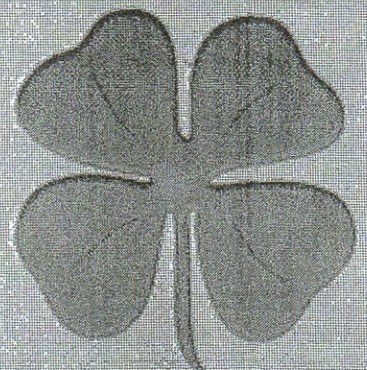

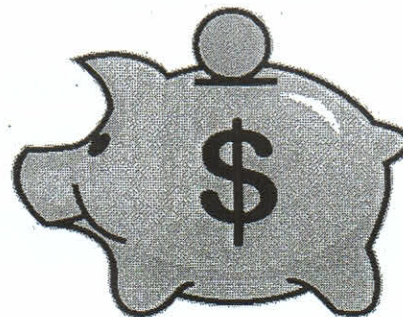
